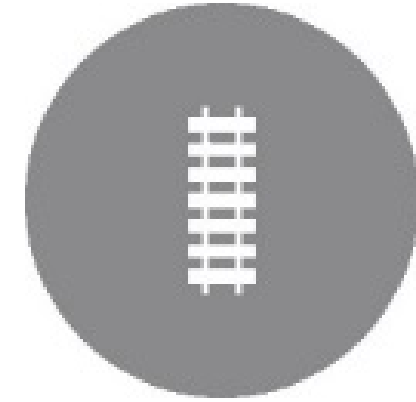

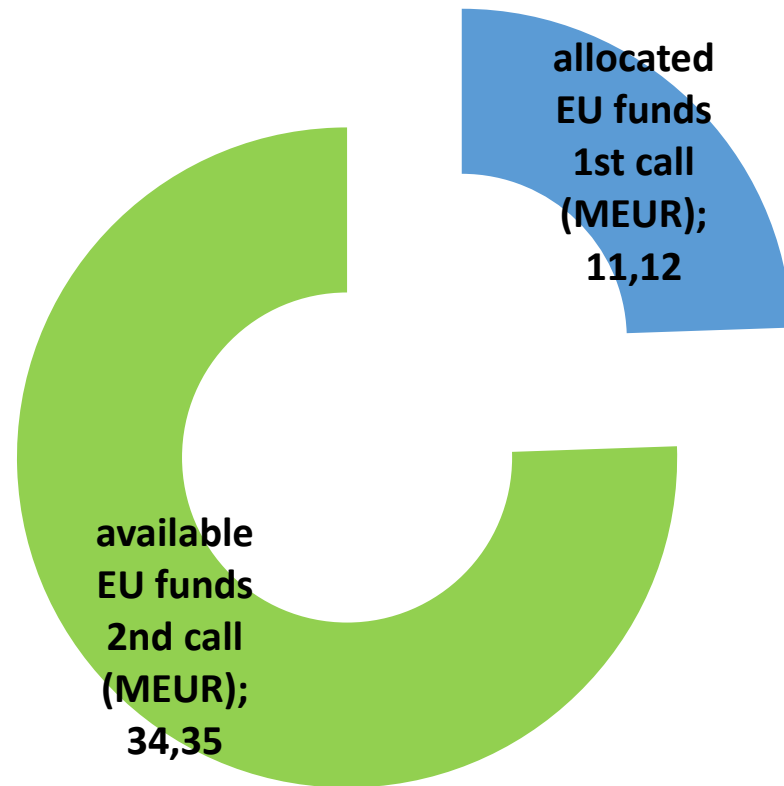

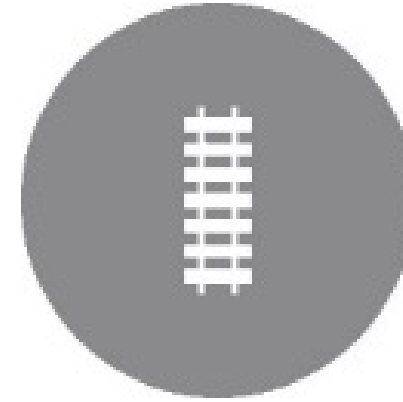

ARIEL - Promoting small-scale fisheries and aquaculture transnational networking in Adriatic-Ionian macroregion

- **Total budget:** 1,25 MEUR
- **Lead applicant:** National Research Council (Italy)
- **Partnership:** Italy (3 partners), Greece (2 partners), Croatia(2 partners), Montenegro (2 partners)
- The goal is to promote technological and non-technological solutions for innovation of small-scale fishery and aquaculture in Adriatic-Ionian basin, involving scientists, policy makers and entrepreneurs.

TOUREST - Tourism water management for sustainable ADRION coastal areas

- **Total budget:** 0,97 MEUR
- **Lead applicant:** Region of Sterea Ellada (Greece)
- **Partnership:** Greece (2 partners), Croatia (1 partner), Italy (2 partners), Slovenia (2 partners)
- The goal is to develop sustainable tourism policies & practices to increase water efficiency in ADRION coastal areas, seeking to minimise the negative impacts of tourism activities on natural heritage and to protect increasingly scarce water resources.

ADRIPASS - Integrating multimodal connections in the Adriatic-Ionian region

- **Total budget:** 1,46 MEUR
- **Lead applicant:** Central European Initiative (Italy)
- **Partnership:** Croatia (1 partner), Greece (2 partners), Italy (3 partners), Slovenia (1 partner), Montenegro (1 partner), Albania (1 partner), Serbia (1 partner), Bosnia and Herzegovina (1 partner)
- The goal is to remove existing bottlenecks and administrative hurdles along the logistic chain, particularly in border sections and ports-hinterland connections, among EU Member States and non Member States (specifically Western Balkans states).
