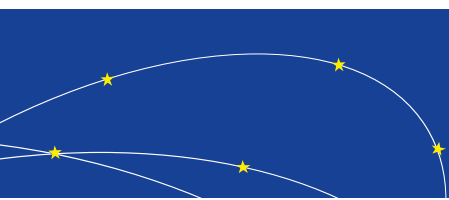
## Bythos - Biotechnologies for Human Health and Blue Growth

The creation of a joint lab in the two areas where researchers and experts in biotechnology, business and industry will come together with local enterprise.

The Lab aims to develop bioactive molecule (BAM)-based antibacterial/antimicrobial/antitumor products from fish waste at zero waste. Fish waste is a potential source of bioactive molecules of interest to the pharmaceutical, nutraceutical and cosmetics industries.

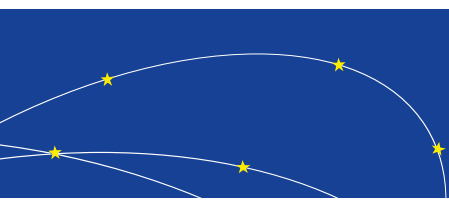

## SiMaSeed - Protecting biodiversity in Sicily-Malta Natura 2000 sites through Seed Banks and population reinforcement

Seeds conservation in germplasm banks (ex situ conservation strategy), the macro- and micropopagation of the targeted species and the restocking (in situ conservation strategy) of their populations in threatened natural habitats of Natura 2000 network.

It will contribute to arrest the loss of biodiversity and to promote a cross-border sustainable development, improving the conservation status of wild flora and promoting its use in environmental restoration and in the nursery sector.

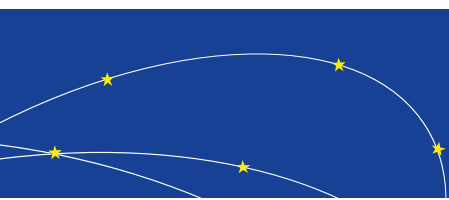


## **CALYPSO SOUTH** - Extending Data and Services for Safer Navigation & Marine Protection

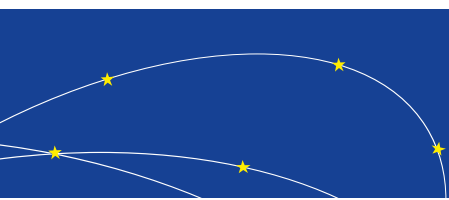
