The INTERREG EUROPE Framework



- Interreg Europe helps regional and local governments across Europe to develop and deliver better policies
- Interreg Europe offers opportunities for regional and local PAs across Europe to share ideas and experience on public policy in practice, therefore improving strategies
- 4 Axes: Research and innovation, SME competitiveness, Lowcarbon economy, Environment and resource efficiency
- 2 Phases and 1 Policy Learning Platform:
 - Phase 1: ILE + practices \rightarrow regional SG \rightarrow Action Plans
 - Phase 2: AP implementation and monitoring


EPICAH in a nutshell


- EPICAH: Effectiveness of Policy Instruments for CrossBorder Advancement in Heritage
- Priority Axis 4: "Environment and resource efficiency"
- Specific Objective: Improving natural and cultural heritage policies [TO 4.1] through a more efficient management of heritage and the development of innovative solutions for a sustainable tourism <u>at cross-border level</u>
- Timing: Jan 2017-Dec 2019 (ph.1) / Jan 2020–Dec 2021 (ph.2)
- Partners: 9 coming from 8 EU regions and representing 13 cross-border countries
- Policy Instruments: 7 (6 cross-border)
- Funds: 1.7 M€




Fostering the generation of 'advanced' thematic **knowledge** and 'high quality' results through the identification of **best practices**






Project integration: development of ICT tools/platforms with common criteria
